

Rosebay Willowherb - *Chamerion angustifolium*



Description

Rosebay willowherb is a distinctively tall plant at its most obvious when the pink spikes of flowers are out through mid to late summer. The plant has spirally arranged, narrow, oval, pointed grey-green leaves and can stand up to 2m tall.

Rosebay willowherb is found in in dry to slightly moist and basic, moderately nutrient rich soils. The species frequently grows in patches on recently disturbed land along verges or in areas following tree felling.
