

## Bugle - *Ajuga reptans*



### Description

Bugle is a small perennial herb, 10-25cm tall with oppositely arranged oval, shallow-toothed leaves set along a single slightly square stem. Blue spikes of flowers bloom through spring and summer.

The plant is found in moist, rich and neutral soils, predominantly in woodland - in particular NVC W7, though also exists throughout W8-11 communities.
