Make Easter Egg Bird Feeders!

Give back this Easter with these wonderful Easter Eggs for Birds! Set up your own trail in the trees for local birds and insects with these fruit and seed 'eggs'. Place the eggs amongst the branches and revisit later to see just how tasty your gifts were!

1. Find a suitable leaf or even some cardboard left over from Easter egg boxes and cut into an egg shape. If you are reusing Easter egg boxes, make sure you carefully peel off and throw away any plastic coating from the packaging.

(If you have any left over Pinecones from last season-they make amazing 3D eggs!)

- Cover egg form in organic, non salted/ non sweetened nut butter (it is very important that it does not contain salt as even a small amount can be toxic for birds)
- Decorate with seeds and fruits (Nyjer seeds, Sunflower seeds, crushed plain Peanuts, dried fruit, small pieces of Apple, Oats and cooked Rice are all great options!)
- 4. Place on a nearby tree for birds and insects to find

(If you make more than one, you can even create a trail for birds to follow)
